



## PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF APPEALS

---

In keeping with the Environmental Protection Act, 1996, the Environmental Protection (Amendment) Act, 2005, and the Environmental Protection Regulations, 2000, any person who may be affected by projects published in the 30-days Public Notice may lodge an appeal in accordance with Section 3.3 of the *Environmental Impact Assessment Guidelines Volume 1: Rules and Procedures for Conducting and Reviewing EIAs, Version 5, November 2004, Environmental Protection Agency/Environmental Assessment Board*.

### Section 3.3 Procedures for Appeal:

#### 1. Appeals under Section 11(3) (a).

- 1.1 Any person who may be affected by a decision of the EPA to exempt a project from the requirement for an EIA may lodge an appeal with the EAB within thirty (30) days of the date of publication of the EPA's decision.
- 1.2 The appeal must be in writing and must set out the reasons why the person appealing believes that an EIA is necessary. A copy of the appeal must be sent to the EPA and the developer.
