National Training Course on Basic Radiation Safety and the Regulation of Radiation Sources

The Environmental Protection Agency in collaboration with the Ministry of Health will be hosting a five-days training workshop on '**Basic Radiation Safety and the Regulation of Radiation Sources**' from April 16-20, 2018, at the Environmental Protection Agency's Boardroom, Ganges Street, Sophia.

Guyana is currently implementing Project RLA 9082, on 'Establishing and Strengthening Sustainable National Regulatory Infrastructures for the Control of Radioactive Sources under the **International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA)**.

The training is one of several initiatives in partnership with **International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA)** based in Austria and will be facilitated by two international consultants. The goal is to build the competence and expertise needed by national regulatory bodies to establish and operate an adequate regulatory programme for the safety and security of radiation sources.
