

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
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Description of the Site

The site for bunkering operation will be conducted in the Essequibo River at Big Kiss Marine Wharf facility located at 127 Parika, East Bank Essequibo.

SDR Petroleum Inc. is leasing from Big Kiss Marine Service Station office space and the wharf facility. SDR Petroleum Inc. main activity is bunkering of which the wharf facility will accommodate the transfer of the product from one vessel into another and also facilitate the relevant authorities to have access and oversee the marking of said product.





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Project Design

Currently there is no development or construction to accommodate the operation for SDR Petroleum Inc. in order to conduct business. The current existing facility as noted prior will assist with docking, transferring and access by the relevant authorities.

As part of the leasing agreement, Bigkiss Marine Wharf facility will provide the following once vessel is docked to port: fresh water and electricity (only for power refrigerator and utility lights in down times)

Waste management from vessel are outlined on the waste management manual submitted prior along with the Garbage Management Certificate.

Project Size

The estimated capital investments are as follows:

- Lease Deposit for Office and Wharf Facility \$3,000,000.00 GUY
- Product Purchase cost based on amount to be imported \$40,000,000.00 to \$60,000,000.00 GUY plus 20% Fuel Tax
- Number of Employees estimated at six to ten
- Number of product importation is expected to be based on Sales. Each importation of the petroleum product is estimated at 700,000 liters.

Explanation of the Project

In a brief summary, once SDR Petroleum Inc. purchase is being made from the refinery and enters Guyana waters, the vessel will be docked at Big Kiss Marine Wharf facility to undertake bunkering operation, marking and the relevant authorities to gain access to the vessel.

Duration of the Project

The estimated duration on each importation will involve the following of which can be between three to six days:

- Custom clearance and fuel Tax paid
- Availability of the relevant authorities to be present on site
- Discharge time from vessel to vessel which is estimated to be six to ten hours.

Potential effect on the Environment

There may be a very minimum amount of spillage of the product when bunkering will be conducted.



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Plans to Mitigate Environmental Impact

Submitted prior with the application for Bunkering sales are the Ship to Ship Transfer Plan and Oil Pollution Emergency Plan (SOPEP) of which will be enforce should an event occur.
