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


About Our Founder

After completing medical studies and training at the University of Miami, Dr. Michael Kotler began his medical career as an Emergency Medicine provider in South Florida. In 1991, he relocated to Louisiana as the Southeast United States Regional Medical Director for InPhyNet Medical Management. He founded Pelican State Outpatient Center in Harahan, LA in 2000. Pelican Outpatient Center has since remained a leader of both Occupational Medicine and Urgent Care with over 200,000 patients yearly.

After analyzing the demographics of Pelican patients, Dr. Kotler founded RemoteMD in 2008 as a direct response to patient well-being and his concern for healthcare accessibility in remote and austere work sites.

The medical staff is composed of devoted Board-Certified Physicians, Registered Nurses, Registered X-Ray Technologists, Certified Medical Assistants, Occupational Coordinators, and office personnel with extensive backgrounds in Occupational Medicine, Emergency Medicine/Urgent Care, Internal Medicine, and Family Practice. RemoteMD physicians are trained in importance of physical exams to ensure Guyana Logistics & Support Services' employees are fully compliant to all company requirements. Additionally, physicians are experienced managing job-related injuries and illnesses.



Additional Services

Medical Control – RemoteMD's full-time staff of physicians are available 24/7/365 for medical consults with our remote paramedics. To ensure paramedics have immediate access to the physicians, RemoteMD maintains three physicians on call at any one time. Incoming calls are automatically routed to the next available physician guaranteeing 99.9% first call answer.

On-site Industrial Remote Environment Medical Specialist (IREMS) – Our IREMS are all full-time paramedics who function as physician extenders in the field and are all cross-trained to multi-task in the following roles:

- HSE (OSH, Occupational Safety & Health Specialist)
- Wellness Programs (Customized to suit the work environment)
- Clerks
- On-site environmental health and hygiene audits and compliance

RemoteMD can secure other levels of providers such as Physician Assistants (PA), Nurses (RN), Nurse Practitioners (NP) or Physicians (MD) based on the project requirements.

Telemedicine – RemoteMD's proprietary camera system is designed to assist the remote paramedic and the physician to achieve a higher level of care by virtually putting the physician in the treatment room. RMD's use of HIPAA compliant audio/video instrumentation allows our shore-based physicians to see and hear in real time which enhances the decision-making process, decreasing LTIs.

Corporate Medical Direction – RemoteMD can assist with the development, implementation, and management of corporate medical policies and procedures such as health service requirements, medical emergency response plans, health & hygiene compliance, and wellness programs. RMD routinely reviews standard medical & equipment packages (SMP) and makes recommendations for specific areas of operation.

Medical Case Management - RemoteMD physicians are knowledgeable in industry regulations and possess the medical expertise required to review, analyse, and make recommendations on both work related and personal health cases. These services include coordinating follow up care within the RemoteMD network of specialists and maintaining communication with those specialists when applicable. This option will be tailored to meet the needs of the client and the patient.

Education & Training – RemoteMD delivers world class education initiatives for health care professionals working in the industrial remote environment. Recognizing an urgent need for advanced knowledge and skills in remote medicine, Dr. Michael Kotler (RemoteMD Founder and Chief Medical Officer) developed a unique program called OccuMedics to provide paramedics with the advanced training and skill sets necessary to work in the remote environment. Ensuring RemoteMD's highly trained field staff remain the best in the business, RMD field personnel are required to refresh Occumedics every two years.

Technology – Our electronic boarding and separation management tool is designed to help ensure a safe working environment from a medical perspective for your company and your employees. Employees submit reports through our encrypted HIPAA compliant web portal which are reviewed by our medical team familiar with the work environment and job description to determine whether medications and/or medical conditions are appropriate for the work setting. We also have several software applications including an electronic patient contact report (PCR) and electronic medical record (EMR) under development.
