Notice to the Public

Pursuant to Section 11(2) of the Environmental Protection Act, Cap. 20:05, Laws of Guyana, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has screened the application for the grant of an environmental permit for the following proposed project:

***Lucky Star Trading – Manufacturing Facility and Storage Bond at Plot A7
Plantation Sage Pond, Eccles-Ramsburg, East Bank Demerara***

The EPA has determined that this project will not significantly affect the environment, and is therefore exempt from the requirement to conduct an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). The reasons for its decision include:

- 1) Given the nature of the project (manufacturing of windows, doors, floor decking and zinc sheets) the facility will be enclosed, thus, reducing the emission of pollutants related to air, water and noise. Therefore, any impacts will be negligible to low, short-term and localized.
- 2) The project is located in an area designated for industrial use and will therefore reduce both direct/indirect impacts on human health and the environment.
- 3) The project is not located within an environmentally sensitive area i.e., it is not located in an area having special environmental attributes that require special care or rare ecosystems or habitats with species at risk.

Please be advised that this decision is in no way an indication that this project is approved.
