Notice to the Public

Pursuant to Section 11(2) of the Environmental Protection Act, Cap. 20:05, Laws of Guyana, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has screened the application for the grant of an Environmental Permit for the following proposed project:

AJM Enterprise – Concrete Batching Plant at Lot 712 Block XXIII Plantation, Great Diamond, East Bank Demerara.

The EPA has determined that this project will not significantly affect the environment, and is therefore exempt from the requirement to conduct an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). The reasons for the EPA's decision include:

- 1) Impacts on air quality will be negligible given that the concrete batching system will be enclosed, material stockpiles will be covered with tarpaulins, and a wet suppression method will also be employed to reduce dust;
- 2) Impacts on noise quality will be negligible given that all noise-generating equipment or machinery will be used with the necessary muffling apparatus to reduce operational noise to acceptable levels;
- 3) Impacts on water quality will be negligible given portable sediment pond, will be constructed to facilitate the catching and trapping of all waste products from the washdown;
- 4) The project is located in an industrial area, and there is no residential dwelling within an estimated 400-meter radius.
