



Environmental Protection Agency Notice to the Public

Pursuant to Section 11(2) of the Environmental Protection Act, Cap. 20:05, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) screened the application for the grant of an environmental permit for the following proposed project:

Anthony's Funeral Home – Operation of a Funeral Home located at Lot 9, Section B, No. 40 Dingwall, Corentyne, Berbice.

The EPA has determined that this project will not significantly affect the environment, and is therefore exempt from the requirement to conduct an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). The reasons for its decision include:

1. The potential for odour nuisance will be confined to the body preservation section within the boundaries of the project.
2. Impacts from noise will be low and periodic. The noise assessment conducted by the Agency revealed that the facility is within the daytime and nighttime limits stipulated in the GNBS Guidelines for Noise Emission into the Environment for a Residential Area.
3. Impacts on water quality will be low. The effluent generated from the facility will be collected, treated, and stored in a holding tank.
4. Hazardous and non-hazardous waste will not be significant and will not pose any risk to human health and the environment. All hazardous waste will be handled in accordance with the Hazardous Waste Management Regulations 2000.
