Notice to the Public

Pursuant to Section 11(2) of the Environmental Protection Act, Cap. 20:05, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) screened the application for the grant of an environmental permit for the following proposed project:

Armoroc Construction & Engineering Inc– Storage of Stone and Sand at Plot CC, Amelia's Ward, Linden.

The EPA has determined that this project will not significantly affect the environment, and is therefore exempt from the requirement to conduct an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). The reasons for its decision include:

- 1) The project will be located within an area that is not environmentally sensitive i.e., it does not have special environmental attributes that require special care or rare ecosystems or habitats with species at risk.
 - i. The project will be located within an industrial area with the closest residents approximately 99.33m North and 220.39m North-West respectively.
- 2) Dust screens will be erected around the facility to limit the dust blown in the direction of the residents. Additionally, wet suppression will be used when the aggregate is offloaded and periodically when the aggregate is stockpiled to reduce wind dispersion of the particles.
