Notice to the Public

Pursuant to Section 11(2) of the Environmental Protection Act, Cap. 20:05, Laws of Guyana, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has screened the application for the grant of an environmental permit for the following proposed project:

Azadi Farms –Crop Cultivation and Poultry Rearing (only) at 84, Kuru Kururu, Agricultural Layout Soesdyke, Linden Highway

The EPA has determined that this project will not significantly affect the environment, and is therefore exempt from the requirement to conduct an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). The reasons for its decision include:

1. The proposed site for the facility has been deemed appropriate for the activity as per lease of State lands for Agricultural purposes provided by the Guyana Lands and Survey Commission (GL&SC).
2. Impacts from Air pollution (odour) will be minimal during operational phases and would be short termed, localized and mitigated.
3. The project's activities are anticipated to yield minimal to negligible impacts on the pre-existing biodiversity and ecosystem within the project area due to the project's commitment to conserving the region's biodiversity.
4. Waste generated by the facility will undergo recycling, reuse, and disposal processes that are in compliance with the regulatory directives of the Agency.
