Notice to the Public

Pursuant to Section 11(2) of the Environmental Protection Act, Cap. 20:05, Laws of Guyana, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has screened the application for the grant of an environmental permit for the following proposed projects:

- **Mr. George Baijnauth – *Baijnauth & Son's Limited (Logging Concession) at BCE 41/85 Left Bank Canje River, Right Bank Kari-Kari River.***
- **Mr. George Baijnauth – *Baijnauth & Son's Limited (Logging Concession) at BCE 08/10 Left Bank Kari-Kari River, Right Bank Good Prospect Creek.***

The EPA has determined that these projects will not significantly affect the environment, and are therefore exempt from the requirement to conduct an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). The reasons for its decision include:

1. The potential impacts of the projects on the physical, biological, and socioeconomic environment will be low, localized and will not have significant impacts on the ecosystem.
2. The existing logging operations are of a small scale and include the harvesting of logs, and the cutting and transporting of lumber.
3. The potential for noise and vibrations from the falling of trees, loading, and offloading of lumber, and the use of heavy-duty vehicles at the operations is negligible considering the frequency and duration of such activities and the location of the concessions.
4. The projects will generate domestic solid waste and sawdust which will be buried within the concessions. The project will also produce hazardous waste (waste oil) which will be appropriately stored and re-used in keeping with the Agency's Hazardous Waste Guidelines.

Please be advised that this decision is in no way an indication that these projects are approved.
