

Environmental Protection Agency Notice to the Public

Pursuant to Section 11(2) of the Environmental Protection Act, Cap. 20:05, Laws of Guyana, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has screened the application for the grant of an environmental permit for the following proposed project:

 Pavitranand Tamardhooj, Bickram Tamardhooj Son Establishment (Logging Concession), located at Dem 24/15 Right Bank Mahaicony River; Right Bank Sawari Creek.

The EPA has determined that these projects will not significantly affect the environment and are therefore exempt from the requirement to conduct an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) for the following reasons:

- 1. <u>Selective</u> and <u>reduced impact</u> logging techniques will be used to lower impacts on the environment including biodiversity.
- 2. Noise and vibrations will be managed by avoiding or limiting night operations and conducting regular maintainance of machinery.
- 3. Woodwaste will be repurposed; waste-oil safely stored and repurposed; and kitchen waste composted.
