



Environmental Protection Agency Notice to the Public

Pursuant to Section 11(2) of the Environmental Protection Act, Cap. 20:05, Laws of Guyana, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has screened the application for the grant of an environmental permit for the following proposed project:

J.R. Construction and Environmental Solution – Waste (Sewage) Collection and Transportation Service – Regions 5 & 6

The EPA has determined that this project will not significantly affect the environment, and is therefore exempt from the requirement to conduct an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). The reasons for its decision include:

1. The waste is transported to a designated site, that is, the New Amsterdam Waste Disposal Site.
2. The impacts associated with air quality (odour) at the collection sites are expected to be low and localized given the short time (approx. 20 minutes) taken for the process to be conducted.
3. Noise emissions at the collection sites are expected to be low and within the limits stipulated in the GNBS Guidelines for Noise Emission into the Environment for Residential Areas.
4. Vibration will be expected primarily during the transportation from the movement of the heavy-duty trucks on the roadways. However, vibrations are expected to be short-term and localized.

Please be advised that this decision is in no way an indication that this project is approved.
