Notice to the Public

Pursuant to Section 11(2) of the Environmental Protection Act, Cap. 20:05, Laws of Guyana, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has screened applications for environmental authorisation for proposed projects as follows:

- **N. Hussain & Sons Enterprise Inc, Logging within Ess 32/25 Right Bank Kaburi River.**
- **N. Hussain & Sons Enterprise Inc, logging within Ess 31/25 Right Bank Kaburi, River Bartica, Potaro Road.**
- **Bibi Meligat, Logging within NWD 09/25 Left Bank Barama, River & Left Bank Takutu Creek Right Bank Powis Creek.**
- **Alwyn Bynoe, Logging within (SFA No. Ess 03/18), at Left Bank Essequibo River, Left Bank Muruwa River, Left Bank North Muruwa River.**
- **Trans Amazon Trading, Logging within (SFA No. Dem 48/08), Right Bank, Yawakuri River, Right Bank Umbambaru Creek, Right & Left Bank.**

The EPA has determined that these projects will not significantly affect the environment and are therefore exempt from the requirement to conduct an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) for the following reasons:

1. Selective and reduced impact logging techniques will be used to lower impacts on the environment including biodiversity.
2. Noise and vibrations will be managed by avoiding or limiting night operations and conducting regular maintenance of machinery.
3. Woodwaste will be repurposed; waste-oil safely stored and repurposed; and kitchen waste composted.

Please be advised that this decision is in no way an indication that this project is approved.
