Notice to the Public

Pursuant to Section 11(2) of the Environmental Protection Act, Cap. 20:05, Laws of Guyana, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has screened the application for the grant of an Environmental Permit for the following proposed project:

Pacaraima Building Supplies Inc. – Manufacturing of Concrete Blocks at Lot 1 Block A “T” Huis Te Coverden, East Bank Demerara.

The EPA has determined that this project will not significantly affect the environment, and is therefore exempt from the requirement to conduct an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). The reasons for the EPA’s decision include:

- 1) Impacts on air quality will be negligible given that stockpiles will be stored in a partially enclosed area, storage height will not exceed 15ft, as well as the concrete blocks will be manufactured under a shed;
- 2) Impacts on noise quality will be negligible given that all noise-generating equipment or machinery will be used with the necessary muffling apparatus to reduce operational noise to acceptable levels;
- 3) Impacts on water quality will be negligible given wastewater shall be channeled into well-designed internal drains with a water filtration system (silt trap);
- 4) The project is located in an agricultural/commercial, and there is no residential dwelling within an estimated 250-meter radius.
