



Environmental Protection Agency Notice to the Public

Pursuant to Section 11(2) of the Environmental Protection Act, Cap. 20:05, Laws of Guyana, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has screened the application for the granting of an environmental authorisation for the following proposed project:

Ronald Arjune – Construction and Operation of a Port Facility (Aggregate Storage) – located at Lot 32 Mud Lot, New Amsterdam, Berbice.

The EPA has determined that this project, for the following reasons, will not significantly affect the environment and is, therefore, exempt from the requirement to conduct an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA):

1. The project site is situated downwind and is located in a sparsely populated, commercially zoned area. The surrounding lands consist primarily of vacant, vegetated plots with no known ecological sensitivity.
2. Impacts from particulate matter and gaseous emissions, from the use of heavy-duty machines/vehicles, and generators will be localised and short-term and not expected to exceed WHO standards. Wet suppression will be used to control particulate matter from material aggregate storage stockpiles.
3. Noise and vibration during construction activities will be short-term, localised, within GNBS limits, and restricted to the daytime.
4. Hazardous wastes will mainly comprise fuel and lubricants for use by heavy-duty vehicles; these chemicals will be adequately contained and/or disposed of to reduce adverse risks to human health and the environment.
