Notice to the Public

Pursuant to Section 11(2) of the Environmental Protection Act, Cap. 20:05, Laws of Guyana, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has screened the application for the grant of an environmental permit for the following proposed project:

Sino Estates & Management Inc – Foam Concrete Blocks & Prefab Concrete Products at Lot 34-36 Section 'B' Triumph Backlands, East Coast Demerara.

The EPA has determined that this project will not significantly affect the environment and is therefore exempt from the requirement to conduct an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). The reasons for its decision include:

- 1) The proposed project location is not environmentally sensitive; it has no special environmental attributes, rare ecosystems, habitats, or species at risk.
- 2) Adequate measures to mitigate emissions to soil, water, and air were outlined in the project's application for environmental authorization.
 - a. Raw materials, such as cement and foaming additives, will be stored in an enclosed 40ft metal container, and sand heaps will be kept to a height not greater than 4ft and will be covered.
 - b. Noise-generating equipment will be affixed with a sound-muffling mechanism.
 - c. Wastewater will be channeled into internal drains equipped with a filtration system.

Please be advised that this decision is in no way an indication that this project is approved.
