Notice to the Public

Pursuant to Section 11(2) of the Environmental Protection Act, Cap. 20:05, Laws of Guyana, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has screened the applications for the grant of an environmental permit for the following proposed projects:

- 1. Timber Link Lumber Yard, Operation of a Lumberyard (Without Processing), at Parcel 1383 Block XXIV, Plantation Meten-Meer-Zorg, West Coast Demerara, Region 3.**
- 2. A&N Lumber Dealer, Operation of a Lumberyard (Without Processing), at Sublot 1 being part of Tract 'X' of Lot 3 part of Block 'A', West Bank Demerara River, Plantation Vreed-en-Hoop, Region 3.**

The EPA has determined that these projects will not significantly affect the environment, and are therefore exempt from the requirement to conduct an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). The reasons for EPA's decision include:

1. Noise and vibration levels will be minimal and will be mitigated by limiting loading/offloading of lumber to between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mon-Sat.; use of tyres during offloading; and regular maintenance of machinery.
2. Wood waste will be given to community members and other wastes disposed via a disposal service.
