Notice to the Public

Pursuant to Section 11(2) of the Environmental Protection Act, Cap. 20:05, Laws of Guyana, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has screened the application for the grant of an environmental permit for the following proposed project:

ANSA McAL Trading Limited. – Manufacturing of Concrete Blocks and Operation of a Bulk Paint Storage Facility at Lots 2-7 Milmount, West Bank Demerara.

The EPA has determined that this project will not significantly affect the environment, and is therefore exempt from the requirement to conduct an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). The reasons for its decision include:

- 1) The potential impacts of the project on the physical, biological, and socioeconomic environment will not be significant, given that the production of the concrete blocks and the storage of paints will be done in an enclosed and controlled environment.
- 2) The project is not located within an environmentally sensitive area, i.e., it is not located in an area having special environmental attributes that require special care or rare ecosystems or habitats with species at risk.
- 3) The application and project summary submitted outlined adequate mitigation measures for air, noise, water & soil impacts from the project.
