Project Type: Logging within State Forest Authorization (SFA) Concession

The project activity is to undertake storage of logs that is being transported via steel boats and steel punts from various concessions issued by GFC to the Tacama waterfront to be loaded onto trucks and trailer, which are contacted from various contractors.

The timber depot license was issued by the Guyana Forestry Commission and will expire on December 31st, 2024.

Logs are harvested based on the stipulated measures set out in the Guidelines for Forest Operations, by GFC. Workers residing within the Amerindian communities that are found nearby are contracted for short periods of time to truck and load logs onto punts.

Working hours will be from 6:00am to 18:00 from Monday to Friday. Works are carried out on some weekends to the fulfillment of orders.

. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) will be provided to all employees inclusive of long boots, helmets, gloves, and visibility vest. Additionally, one first aid and snake bit kits are always present on site.

Trucks are fuel at the gas station by respective drivers.

Environmental Effects

The following potential environmental effects may be generated from the logging operation:

Noise Nuisance

The source of noise will be from the operation of the log loader and outboard engine. However, noise level generated is expected to be managed as best possible since there is a small population of community settlers around.

Fire

Flammable substances such as gas and diesel are stored onsite and if not managed properly can be ignited if a worker/s who may smoke and discards a lit cigarette butt.

Vibration

Vibrations generated from the use of the log loader and outboard engine.

Particulate Matter (dust)

It is expected that dust will be emitted from the lifting of the logs with the log loader and the use of the primary and secondary roads, and some extend skids trails especially during dry weather.

Mitigation Measures

Noise Nuisance

All machinery and/or equipment will be worked during working hours. The machines and/or equipment's will be serviced and maintained according to manufacturer's specifications to aid in the reduction of excessive noise. Workers will be provided with appropriate PPE including hearing protection.

Fire

All employees will be trained in the use of the fire extinguishers.


Vibration

The machines will only be working when the need arises as to minimize vibration.

Particulate Matter (dust)

During the dry weather, the speed limit of 30km/hr. will be adhered to. The employees will be given appropriate PPE to protect them from dust.
