Notice to the Public

Pursuant to Section 11(2) of the Environmental Protection Act, Cap. 20:05, Laws of Guyana, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has screened the application for the grant of an environmental permit for the following proposed project:

Coosal's Guyana Construction Incorporated. – Concrete Batching Plant at Tract TJ Rome, East Bank Demerara.

The EPA has determined that this project will not significantly affect the environment, and is therefore exempt from the requirement to conduct an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). The reasons for its decision include:

- 1) The nature of the project (operation of a concrete batching plant) – a closed (concrete batching) system as well as covered conveyors and aggregate stockpiles thus, reducing the emission of pollutants related to air and water. Therefore, any impacts will be negligible to low, short-term, and localized.
- 2) The project will not be located within an environmentally sensitive area i.e., it is not located in an area having special environmental attributes that require special care or rare ecosystems or habitats with species at risk.
- 3) The application and project summary submitted outlined adequate mitigation measures for air & noise emissions from the project.
