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### Waste Disposable:

All paper waste and kitchen waste are disposed by clearance weekly by the public system, the weekly clearance schedule as set out by the Mayor and City Council of Georgetown. The daily weight of all paper and kitchen waste is estimated to be ten pounds daily.

### Bio- Hazard Waste 1:

All waste materials of this type e.g., Syringes, needles, tubes, contaminated materials are disposed in sealed containers e.g., Sharp Containers and these are taken to the Solid Waste Disposable Unit located at Georgetown Public Hospital Corporation for disposal, a signed record of the quantity and size of containers dispatched is maintained as part of permanent record of the Clinic for future reference.

### Bio-Hazard Waste 2:

In the event of disposal of any tissue sample removed during an operating procedure that requires the above Clinic to undertake its destruction. This is done with the help of Memorial Gardens and Crematorium, with whom we have had this arrangement since its inception. The sample is labelled with all the required patient information and a signed letter of release of the said sample is obtained. A copy of these documents is collected by the personnel from Memorial Gardens and Crematorium on the collection of said sample.
