****Project Description***

Our operations involve the procurement of low sulfuric diesel from trusted suppliers, which is then transported via tanker vessels to our storage facility at Mining Lease No. 450, Region 10. Upon arrival, the diesel is offloaded into our one-million-gallon storage tank, ensuring adequate supply for distribution. Subsequently, the diesel is loaded onto boats and trucks for wholesale and retail distribution to clients across various industries.

****Operation Phase****

The project encompasses multiple phases, including procurement, transportation, storage, and distribution. Each phase is meticulously executed to maintain product integrity, meet customer demand, and optimize operational efficiency.

****Potential Environmental Impacts and Management Measure****

Improper waste management can be unsightly and impact water quality.

Mitigation

The following measures are being implemented to manage waste during the operation:

- Garbage including office waste and waste from small packaging, such as paper, cardboard and plastic and food waste such as boxes, wrappers, tins and bottles and residual food will be collected in bins provided at strategic locations around the facility. Waste disposal services provided by the Woodlands – Bel Air NDC will be utilised to disposed of garbage.
- For sewage waste a septic tank will be installed to receive and treat waste from the toilets.
- Waste oil from servicing of the generator and machinery will be collected in drip containers and then consolidated in 45-gallon drums.

Good sanitation, hygienic and housekeeping practices will be maintained at all times
