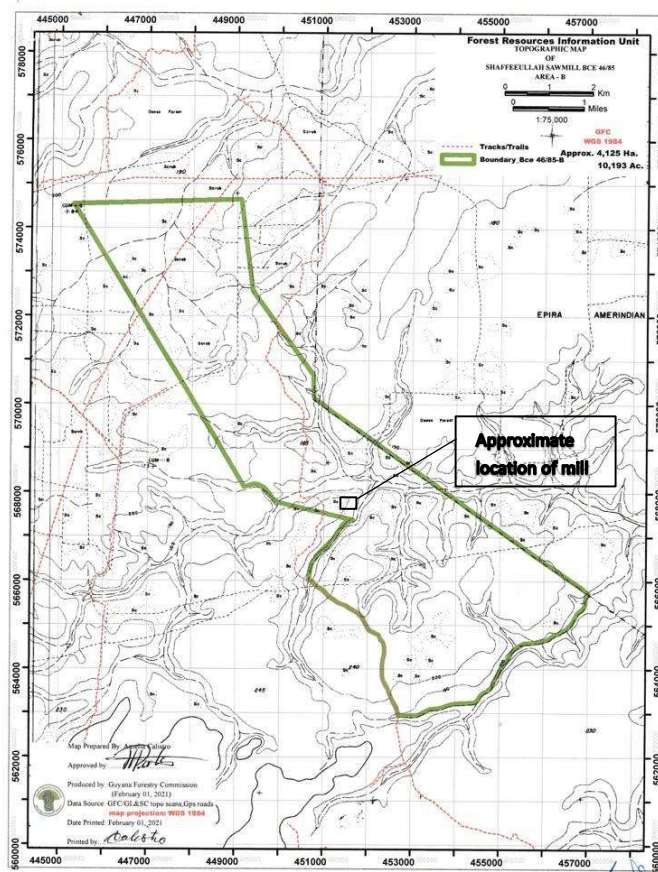

## Description of Project:

SFA No. Bce 46/85 is located approximately 100 miles up the Corentyne River (right and left banks Epira River, West Epira Amerindian Reservation). The concession was being used primarily for logging until August of 2010, we conducted a thorough internal review of our operations and found that it was more efficient to operate our sawmill inside of the concession. Due to the location of the concession, it is mainly being accessed via the Corentyne river.

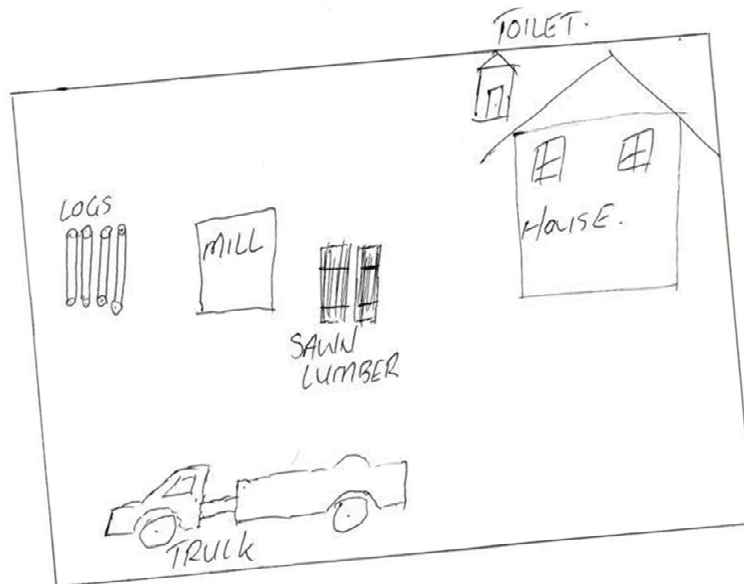


**Figure 1. Map Showing the Location of the Logging Concession and Surrounding Environment**

### Description of the Design of the Project:

- Approximately Thirty Million Guyana Dollars (30,000,000.00 GYD) was invested into the projects, for the purchasing of the sawmill, chainsaws, skidder, and trucks.
- Total land Area of the concession: 19,814 Acres

Dressed and Undressed Lumber, Sand,  
Stone and Road Building Materials

- The operation includes the felling of logs by the use of a chainsaw, logs are then hauled to the Sawmill Site by the use of a skidder. The logs are then cut into lumber using a lucas mill, the lumber is then strapped together in bundles and transported to the waterfront by the use of a Truck. At the waterfront the material is loaded into barges and transported to our location in Crabwood Creek where it is dressed and sold.
- Storage of Diesel Fuel: approved containers are used for storing of diesel, it is placed at a safe location away from any sources of ignition.
- Toilet Facilities: Pit Latrine
- Water Sources: water from a streaming creek nearby is used for domestic purposes.

1	Waste Oil from Machines	Waste Oil generated from the machines are reused for painting of our barges and marine equipment.
2	Sawdust	Sawdust generated from the cutting of logs into lumber are used for landfilling within the concession.
3	Domestic Waste	Domestic Waste generated from workers is being buried.
