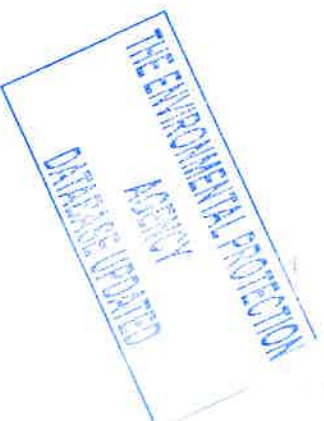

OPERATIONS/PROJECT DESIGN

I have been operating a forestry concession for several years, where logs and piles are harvested using chainsaws. These are then sold to mills for further processing.

We are currently operating at approximately ninety percent self-sufficient.

We uses solar energy with minimal dependency on diesel generator.

We have fresh water supply form a creek that runs through the concession. This is further treated with water purification tablets.

We grow our own vegetable and fruits for consumption.

Communication is limited to internet service, as there in no telephone service.

Waste is limited to domestic waste which is mitigated through landfill.

4. PROJECT SIZE:

I am currently operating on a small scale level with maximum employees of seven at any one-time.

The investment for this project including machinery is approximately Forty Million dollars (\$40,000,000).

The rate of production is determined by the Guyana Forestry Commission, which is guided by the Low Carbon Development Strategy.

The project is intended to continue, as long as it continue to be financially viable.

POTENTIAL ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECTS

Given that the waste generated from the project is natural and biodegradable, there are no foreseeable negative effects on the environment. The project is in an area that has no domestic dwelling in its proximity, therefore it has no impact on anyone from the noise generated.
