Notice to the Public

Pursuant to Section 11(2) of the Environmental Protection Act, Cap. 20:05, Laws of Guyana, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has screened the application for the grant of an environmental permit for the following proposed project:

Navindra Nauth Vesar – Operation of a Natesh & Sons Lumber without processing at lot 194, no. 77, Housing Scheme, Corentyne, Berbice

The EPA has determined that this project will not significantly affect the environment, and is therefore exempt from the requirement to conduct an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). The reasons for its decision include:

1. The potential for air emission (dust) is of low significance since the facility only buys, stores, and re-sells lumber (without any lumber processing activities).
2. The potential for noise from the loading and offloading of lumber at the facility is negligible considering the frequency, timing (daytime), and duration of such activities and the facility's proximity to surrounding residents.
3. The project only generates domestic solid waste that will be stored in covered bins and collected once per week by the Corriverton Mayor & Town Council.

Please be advised that this decision is in no way an indication that this project is approved.
