

# Project Summary

Trade Hind Enterprise Inc. acquired three (3) blocks #. GS23: T-1011|MP|000|20  
GS23: T-1011|MP|003|20  
T-1011|MP|001

These blocks were allocated for the purpose of sand and loam extraction. The exploration process is completed and the company is now in the mobilisation process.

The EPA was consulted. Three (3) separate applications were submitted for each block. These blocks are located opposite each other. The extraction process should take place within three (3) months prior to the EPA consultation process being granted by the EPA.

The system of extraction to be adopted is the conveyor belt system. Sand will be extracted Monday to Sunday, depending on the demand. Sand extracted by the equipment at 950 bucket wheel loader among other which will be channel to conveyor which is further separated from braches, stones by a machine. The sand will be stored openly to the loading pier that is easily accessible by machinery to load into a barge. The barge will transport sand and loam once a week to both local and European markets.

Working days will be Monday to Sunday, 8:00 am to 16:30 pm. An office will be constructed onsite upon the establishment of the operation. The administration building should include toilet and bathroom facilities for staff, lunch area, changing room and check point.

A septic tank system will be established with the number of toilets to be attached (unknown). A total of 10 employees will be hired to work at the facility which includes admin staff. PPE will be provided to each employee such as hi-visibility vest, hard hats, steel tip boot, eye goggles, respirator and ear muffs.

Fuel will be stored onsite less than 2000 litres. 1145 gallon drums in a contained impervious area, well ventilated. Despite each block will be permitted separately, the blocks will be not be worked simultaneously. Hence one block at a time.

Reclamation and restriction will be done in accordance with the requirement by both EPA and GMC.



The types of equipment and other relevant information can be found in the Company's Mining Plan. A copy will be made available to the EPA. All protocols will be observed and permit conditions adhered to by the Company.
